

MATTHEW 27

33 And when they had come to a place called Golgotha, that is to say, Place of a Skull,  
34 they gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink.  
But when He had tasted it,  
He would not drink

35a Then they crucified Him,  
38 Then two robbers were crucified with Him, one on the right and another on the left.

37 And they put up over His head the accusation written against Him:  
THIS IS  
JESUS  
THE KING OF THE JEWS.

36 Sitting down,  
they kept watch over Him there.

35b and divided His garments,

casting lots,

that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet:“They divided My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots.”

MARK 15

22 And they brought Him to the place Golgotha, which is translated, Place of a Skull.  
23 Then they gave Him wine mingled with myrrh to drink,

but He did not take it.

25 Now it was the third hour, and they crucified Him.  
27 With Him they also crucified two robbers, one on His right and the other on His left.  
28 So the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “And He was numbered with the transgressors.”

26 And the inscription of His accusation was written above:

THE KING OF THE JEWS.

24 And when they crucified Him, they divided His garments,

casting lots for them to determine what every man should take.

LUKE 23

32 There were also two others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death.  
33 And when they had come to the place called Calvary,

there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left.

34 **FIRST SAYING FROM THE CROSS:**  
Then Jesus said, “**Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.**”

38 And an inscription also was written over Him  
THIS IS

THE KING OF THE JEWS.

in letters of Greek, Latin, and Hebrew:

34b And they divided His garments

and cast lots.

JOHN 19

17 And He, bearing His Cross,

went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha,

18 where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center.

19 Now Pilate wrote a title and put it on (over) the Cross. And the writing was:

JESUS OF NAZARETH,  
THE KING OF THE JEWS.

20 Then many of the Jews read this title, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city; and it was written in Hebrew, Greek, and Latin.  
21 Therefore the chief priests of the Jews said to Pilate, “Do not write, ‘The King of the Jews,’ but, ‘He said, ‘I am the King of the Jews.’””  
22 Pilate answered, “What I have written, I have written.”

23 Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece. 24 They said therefore among themselves, “Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be,” that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says:“They divided My garments among them,And for My clothing they cast lots.” Therefore the soldiers did these things.

## MATTHEW 27

39 And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads  
40 and saying, **First Saying to the Cross**  
**“You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself!  
If You are the Son of God, come down from the Cross.”**

41 Likewise the chief priests also, mocking with the scribes and elders,said,  
42 **Second Saying to the Cross**  
**“He saved others; Himself He cannot save.  
If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the Cross, and we will believe Him.**

43 **He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now if He will have Him; for He said, ‘I am the Son of God.’”**

44 **Fourth Saying to the Cross**  
Even the robbers who were crucified with Him reviled Him with the same thing.

## MARK 15

29 And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads  
and saying, **First Saying to the Cross**  
**“Aha! You who destroy the temple and build it in three days,  
30 save Yourself,  
  
and come down from the Cross!”**

31 Likewise the chief priests also, mocking among themselves with the scribes, said,  
**Second Saying to the Cross**  
**“He saved others; Himself He cannot save.  
32 Let the Christ, the King of Israel, descend now from the Cross, that we may see and believe.”**

**Fourth Saying to the Cross**  
Even those who were crucified with Him reviled Him.

## LUKE 23

35 And the people stood looking on.

But even the rulers with them sneered, saying,  
**Second Saying to the Cross**  
**“He saved others;**

**let Him save Himself  
if He is the Christ, the chosen of God.”**

36 The soldiers also mocked Him, coming and offering Him sour wine,  
37 and saying, **Third Saying to the Cross**  
**“If You are the King of the Jews, save Yourself.”**

**Fourth Saying to the Cross**

39 Then one of the criminals who were hanged blasphemed Him, saying, **“If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us.”**  
40 But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, “Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation?  
41 And we indeed justly, for we receive the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong.”

42 **Fifth Saying to the Cross.**  
Then he said to Jesus, **“Lord, remember me when You come into Your Kingdom.”**

43 **SECOND SAYING FROM THE CROSS**  
And Jesus said to him, **“Assuredly, I say to you today, you will be with Me in Paradise”**

MATTHEW 27

45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land until the ninth hour

46 FOURTH SAYING FROM the CROSS

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?” that is, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?”

47 6th Saying to the Cross Some of those who stood there, when they heard that, said, “This Man is calling for Elijah!”

48 Immediately one of them ran and took a sponge, filled it with sour wine and put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink.

49 The rest said, “Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to save Him.”

50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice

and yielded up His spirit.

MARK 15

33 Now when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour.

34 FOURTH SAYING FROM the CROSS

And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, “Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?” which is translated, “My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?”

35 6th Saying to the Cross Some of those who stood by, when they heard that, said, “Look, He is calling for Elijah!”

36 Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink, saying,

“Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down”

37 And Jesus cried out with a loud voice,

and breathed His last.

LUKE 23

44 Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour.

45a And the sun was darkened,

46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice,

SEVENTH SAYING FROM THE CROSS

He said, “Father, ‘into Your hands I commit My spirit.’”

Having said this,

He breathed His last.

JOHN 19

25 Now there stood by the Cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother’s sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene.

26 THIRD SAYING FROM THE CROSS

When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing by, He said to His mother,

“Woman, behold your son!”

27 Then He said to the disciple, “Behold your mother!” And from that hour that disciple took her to his own home.

28 FIFTH SAYING FROM THE CROSS

After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, “I thirst!” 29 Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there;

and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth.

30 SIXTH SAYING FROM THE CROSS

So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “It is finished!” (Tetelestai)

And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

**MATTHEW 27**

51 Then, behold,  
the veil of the temple  
was torn in two  
from top to bottom;  
and the earth quaked,  
and the rocks were split,  
52a and the graves were opened...

**54 7th Saying to the Cross**

So when the centurion

and those with him,  
who were guarding Jesus,  
saw

the earthquake  
and the things that had happened,  
they feared greatly,

saying,

**“Truly this was the Son of God!”**

55 And many women, were there

looking on  
from afar,  
who  
followed Jesus from Galilee,  
ministering to Him

56 among whom were Mary Magdalene,  
Mary the mother of James and Josés,  
and the mother of Zebedee’s sons.

**MARK 15**

38 Then  
the veil of the temple  
was torn in two  
from top to bottom.

**39 7th Saying to the Cross**

So when the centurion,  
who stood opposite Him,

saw  
that He cried out like this  
and breathed His last

he  
said,

**“Truly this Man was the Son of God!”**

40a There were also women

looking on  
from afar,  
41 (who also  
when He was in Galilee, followed Him  
and ministered to Him)  
and many other women  
who came up with Him to Jerusalem.  
40b among whom were Mary Magdalene,  
Mary the mother of James the Less and of Josés  
and Salome,

**LUKE 23**

45b and  
the veil of the temple  
was torn in two.

**47 7th Saying to the Cross**

So when the centurion

saw

what had happened,

he glorified God,  
saying,

**“Certainly this was a righteous Man!”**

48 And the whole crowd  
who came together to that sight,  
seeing what had been done,  
beat their breasts and returned.

49a But all His acquaintances,  
and the women

49d watching these things  
49c stood at a distance,

49b who followed Him from Galilee,  
.
